Adoption of Florida Martyr & Servant of God – Cacique Luis

St. Ambrose Catholic Church

The parish of St. Ambrose has adopted a Florida martyr, Cacique Luis (pronounced: kah-'see-keh lu-eese), in the cause for beatification now underway at the diocesan phase with the intentions of fostering a particular devotion to this indigenous martyr, documenting occasions of miraculous intercession, and praying for the Church to honor his sacrifice in defense of the faith.

The word "cacique" means chieftain or leader. Luis is the name he was given upon his initiation into the Church. He was a chieftain of the Apalachee people in one of the villages in the Apalachee province between Tallahassee and Gainesville. Notarized documents indicate that Cacique Luis along with about 20 other Apalachee caciques, in addition to other Florida martyrs, suffered particularly horrific and brutal martyrdom while defending the faith and the Holy Eucharist between January and July 22, 1704.

The Church has declared the Florida Martyrs - Apalachee men, women, and children who numbered in the thousands, together with their Spanish lay teachers, and 13 Spanish priests to be Servants of God. Under the direction of the Postulator Dr. Waldery Hilgeman of Misio Pastoralis in Rome, the Tribunal is interrogating witnesses and the seven scholars of the Historic Commission are completing the research phase of the process. All of the bishops of Florida pray that with the help of God and the prayers of the faithful in Florida, the cause of the Florida Martyrs will proceed to beatification.
